

Adjustment of the temporary RAM surcharge effective April 2, 2026

Prices for the Raspberry Pi Compute Module continue to rise: As of April 1, 2026, Raspberry Pi has once again raised prices significantly — marking the third increase in three months, following hikes in February and March. (source: <https://www.raspberrypi.com/news/a-new-3gb-raspberry-pi-4-for-83-75-and-more-memory-driven-price-increases/>).

In order to offer our customers price stability and planning certainty, we deliberately absorbed the price increase in March at the expense of our own margin. However, the latest adjustment effective April 1 has put us in a situation where we can no longer fully offset this trend. To put this into perspective: Since the beginning of the year, prices for the Compute Modules have risen by an average of around 80% due to the three increases.

In light of this, we are adjusting the RAM surcharge introduced in February, effective April 2, 2026. It is important to us to handle this development transparently: As we have done in the past, we are passing this price increase on to our customers without any additional markup.
