

eMMC surcharge from July 10, 2026

eMMC memory modules are also currently experiencing massive price increases: Following the rise in RAM prices, prices for NAND flash and eMMC memory have also risen sharply worldwide since the beginning of 2026 (Source: <https://www.trendforce.com/presscenter/news/20260202-12911.html>). This is due to the persistently high demand for storage capacity for AI servers, which is causing manufacturers to increasingly shift their production toward higher-margin enterprise products—at the expense of the availability and pricing of eMMC storage, such as that used in our Revolution Pi products.

We have tried to absorb this cost increase for as long as possible. However, given the extent of the price increases, it is no longer possible to fully offset them at the expense of our own margin. For this reason, we are introducing an eMMC surcharge effective July 10, 2026. It is important to us to handle this development transparently: As with the RAM surcharge, we are passing this surcharge on to our customers without adding any additional margin. The eMMC surcharge applies in addition to the existing RAM surcharge, which remains unaffected by this adjustment and continues to apply unchanged.
